World class figure skater featured at club's carnival

The Sparwood Figure Skating Club will be presenting its annual carnival on Saturday, March 31. Called "Sleeping Beauty", two performances will be held at 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. in the arena.

The featured guest skater for the event will be Donald Jackson, the first Canadian to win the world men's figure skating title.

From Oshawa, Ont., the skater brought home the gold medal from Prague, Czechoslovakia in 1962. Prior to that he had won the Canadian men's

championship four years in a row and the North American title twice, and was second in world championships in 1959 and 1960. At Prague, he scored seven perfect 6.0 marks for his free-style program, the most accumulated perfect scores in figure skating at that time, which set a record unequalled before then or until the late 1970's.

His free-style program, besides Jackson's intricate footwork and spins, included a remarkable total of 22 jumps — two tri-

ples, 10 doubles, and 10 singles he landed the first triple Lutz ever performed in international competition and it would be 12 years before another skater repeated Jackson's successful triple Lutz in world competition.

Shortly thereafter, Jackson turned professional. He is a member of Canada's Sports Hall of Fame, the Canadian Amateur Athlete Hall of Fame and the U.S. Figure Skating Association Hall of Fame — a distinction ranking Jackson among those whose competition to the sport of figure skating has been most outstanding. Jackson and his wife Joanne have five children.

He keeps in shape by practicing faithfully and competes in the World Professional Team Competition. Jackson teaches seminars, makes guest appearances at figure skating events across the country and also funds raising events for children and also finds time to promote the family business — Don Jackson's Skating Products.

Sparwood skaters have started carnival practices and invite everyone who enjoys figure skating to come to the carnival. Tickets are on sale at the Sparwood arena and from skaters. Contact Barb Murphy or Irene Talarico.

BUGS WORKED OUT
Si hill may get snow machine

The Swood Kinsmen Winter Recreation Area, which is officially opened the service club last year has had most of the snow worked out and is ready for a successful season a year, according to the president of the Winter Recreation Society, which supervises the day-to-day operation of the ice, downhill slopes, and cross-country area.

Glenn Scott said the three days the was open for skiing on February 19, 20 and 21 allowed the society to test the snow and the entire facility in a dry-run. Now, the area has a clear ice of which involved in the operation of the hill. Even if there no more skiing days this year, the hill will still be ready for next fall. Mr. Scott said in an interview. "The hill looking very

positive ... but we can't overemphasize the poor year for snow." The barren slopes have created financial tension for a new society hoping to have sold at least some lift tickets this winter.

The executive of the society is considering buying a snow-making machine, which will provide more consistent skiing conditions throughout the year and will lengthen the season. "If we get any amount of snow with the support of the snow-making machine we will have an early start and end quite late," Mr. Scott said about a possible October to April season.

Because very few people came to the ski hill last month — and the one's that did were allowed to ski for free — the Winter Recreation Society is encumbered with some im-

mediate debts, Mr. Scott said. "We are stone cold broke and we're in debt," he said about insurance still to be bought and bills for heating and electricity used to run the lights and tow.

Mr. Scott said the executive is considering various revenue-making plans, including developing the area into a summer recreation spot, with the possibility of using it as a campsite.

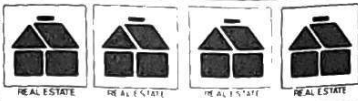

Computer program coming to Elk Valley

A computer with a program to help students make career choices has been given to the Crownest Pass School Division by Crows Nest Resources Ltd.

As well, the mining company has established \$1,000 scholarship fund open to all Crownest Consolidated High School students planning to attend a post-secondary institution.

The computer, an Apple, its software, disc drive and printer were presented to board chairman Cliff Reiling and high school guidance counselor Jerry Rejman last Friday by Cindy Brunel, public affairs representative, and Ray Hughes, supervisor of training and development at Crows Nest's Line Creek mine.

The software is on a three-year lease and is updated annual. The hardware now belongs to the school district. A similar system was given to the Fernie school system last year, and Crows Nest plans similar contributions to Sparwood next year and Elkford the year after, Mr. Hughes said.

The scholarship, which will be based on marks, will be available to students who have not won another major scholarship originating in this area.

The computer system, called "CHOICES," was developed by Employment and Immigration Canada to help secondary students and other adults

study occupations and determine quickly the qualifications and training required for any specific occupation.

Using the computer a student puzzled about where his future may lie can now ask for information on a specific career. The computer will tell him what that career requires in the way of training, aptitudes and ability, as well as provide other information.

Or if a student is not certain what he wants to do, he can put into the computer such information as his marks, interests, skills and other job requirements (such as "prefers outdoors" or "doesn't like cold climates") and the computer will sift through this and provide a list of occupations for which the student is suited.

More than 1,000 career choices are in the program.

High-tech diggers peek underground

Archaeologists can now trace the plan of a buried city without so much as lifting a shovel. Dr. Hector Williams, an archaeologist with the classics department of the University of British Columbia, has been using

computerized scanners and electronic detecting equipment to plot the outlines of ancient cities.

This technique is extremely useful because archaeological digging is both expensive and destructive. Since all the clues to

the site's past are buried, it can be impossible to know where to start digging. There's always the chance of destroying whatever lies underground. Worse, one could dig for weeks without uncovering anything.

Dr. Williams and his research team have been using devices commonly used by miners to detect buried veins of ore. One machine measures the electrical resistance between two points.

An electrical current is passed between two electrodes driven into the ground. If an object blocks the electron stream, the current will pass more slowly, and the resistance reading will be high.

The other machine, called a photon magnetometer, can yield information about underground objects by measuring the magnetic field in a prescribed area. If something

such as a pocket of nickel, or a buried wall — impedes this field, it will register as a lowered reading on the magnetometer.

The information from both machines can then be fed into a desktop computer which will analyse it and produce a picture of what it "sees".

Dr. Williams and his team have used the devices with great success on the ancient Greek city of Stymphalos. After dividing the site into blocks 20 metres square, the archaeologists took electrical resistance and magnetometer readings of each area. The results, when run through the team's Epsom microcomputer, yielded a plan of the city. Unlike most ancient cities, Stymphalos was laid out in a grid plan behind its fortified

walls. When Stymphalos is excavated, the computer-produced plan will allow the archaeologists to go immediately to the important sections of the city. By eliminating random digging, the workers can proceed much faster. This method of determining the town's perimeters and main areas is cheaper, less destructive and

more efficient than digging exploratory wells into the site. Dr. Williams is currently working on an outline of the ancient city of Mytilene, on the island of Lesbos. There is now a modern city on the site, but the archaeologists' up-to-date technology should help them uncover the old without disturbing the new. (Canadian Science News)

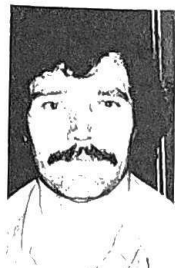

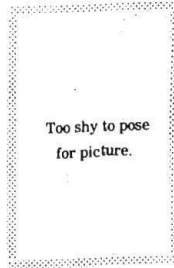
